Congress Proceedings – ISBN numbers

I am pleased to announce that I have finally been able to track down how to obtain International Standard Book Numbers for internationally based organisations' publications (via UNESCO) – and have now allocated ISBN numbers to all 3 congress proceedings. The numbering system is slightly complicated in that at present both 10 digit and 13 digit numbers are being allocated in anticipation of a new 13 digit format coming into effect next year (2007). You can find the specific numbers by visiting the website [Congresses] page, selecting [Proceedings], and then clicking on a congress proceedings link. We hope this will be useful to authors needing a reference for their publication.
