International Journal of Agricultural Management (IJAM) – since the last Newsletter two further editions of the journal have been published on IngentaConnect – Vol.3. #2 and Vol.3. #3 – and I am attaching the Tables of Contents for both editions. Since the launch of the new Journal our Editor – Martyn Warren has kept to his word and produced a new edition every 3 months without fail. It is very pleasing to see so many of the authors are IFMA Members and the Journal is truly international with a wide range of authorship and farm management topics. Congresses – Things are moving on at a pace with the organisation of the next two congresses.

IFMA20 – 2015 in Québec City, Québec, Canada – The organising committee along with Farm Management Canada (FMC) and CRAAQ are well ahead with their plans for the congress next July (2015). You can expect the congress website to be fleshed out from the current flagpage very soon – I expect to let you know that the site has been launched within the next month – and it will carry much of the initial information about the congress. You should register to receive Congress Newsletters once the site is launched. The Venue for the congress will be Laval University, and the dates are Sunday 12th July to Friday 17th July, 2015.

2014 is the 40th anniversary of the formation of the International Farm Management Association – the inaugural meeting was held during the 2nd International Farm Management Congress held in Quelph, Ontario, Canada – so it is great news that we will be celebrating 40 years of IFMA back in Canada at IFMA20.

IFMA21 – 2017 in the City of Edinburgh, Scotland, UK(?*) – The organising committee has started work and the congress will be planned and delivered by the Institute of Agricultural Management (IAgrM) together with Scotland's Rural College (SRUC) based at Edinburgh University. The proposed dates for the congress are Sunday 2nd July to Friday 7th July 2017. (* The ? mark after UK is there because, as you may be aware, the people of Scotland will be voting on whether to stay in the UK or to become independent in September this year.) Either way it will not make a difference to the organisation of the congress.
