## IFMA21 - Registration For the Congress will end on: \*\*Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2017\*\*

Registration for the congress will close on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June, less than 5 weeks away and subject to the number of now limited places still being available. So if you are thinking of attending, you need to make your registration as soon as possible. And once registered you should make your accommodation booking immediately after you have done so. The vast majority of delegates are staying at Pollock Halls (Chancellors Court) where the conference venue is, and where all the field trips and accompanying person tours will start from.

**Remember:** The online registration from the website is for credit card payments only. If you complete the process and do not make a successful payment your registration is lost and you will need to start over again. To start the process you need first to register (right hand column) after clicking on the big green booking button. Once you have done that you can use "log in" should you need to start the process again.

Please read the Registration page before clicking on the big green button at the bottom of the page. I recommend that you contact your card supplier to inform them of a forth coming payment to the Institute of Agricultural Management (IAgrM) before you register. If you need to pay by bank transfer please contact <u>Richard Cooksley</u> to ask for a PDF registration form and the details for making a bank transfer. (You can also use the PDF registration form to pay by credit card.

#### Also - Contributed Paper and Poster presenting authors registration deadline is: Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May

The presenting authors of accepted contributed papers or posters must register by Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May for their paper or poster to be included in the programme and congress proceedings. Papers that are not presented at the congress will not be included in the final publication of the proceedings on the ifmaonline.org website.
